 - Briefly describe your journey into design construction related field and explain why you think you are the best candidate for the scholarship
- 4) Recommendation Letters from at least (2) professors/faculty member in your field.
 - * Failure to submit the complete package will disqualify you as a potential scholarship recipient

Applicants will be notified of the result no later than **June 30**, **2022**. The scholarship will be awarded at our Annual Awards Banquet. (Location: Greater LA area) Recipients are required to be in attendance to receive the award.
